The Scofflaw

£18

Named after the term given to those who clandestinely sipped spirits throughout Prohibition, the Scofflaw debuted in 1924 at Harry's Bar in Paris.

Lot 40 Canadian Rye, Mancino dry vermouth, fresh lemon juice, grenadine and orange bitters.

Air Mail

£20

This potent little drink references the transatlantic postal delivery service that arrived on our doorsteps in 1918.

Havana 3yrs rum, fresh lime juice, honey syrup, green Chartreuse, topped with champagne.

Royal Hawaiian

£18

In tribute to the first and most exclusive hotels on Waikiki Beach the Royal Hawaiian is one of the best tiki classics.

Beehive 24 dry gin, almond syrup, fresh lemon juice and fresh pineapple juice.

The Boulevardier

£18

Created in the 1920's by Erskine Gwynne, the publisher of the "Boulevardier" magazine.

Rebel Yell straight bourbon, Campari and Mancino sweet vermouth.

Hanky Panky

£18

Created by The Savoy's legendary head bartender Ada Coleman in the early twentieth century.

London No. 3 dry gin, Mancino sweet vermouth and Fernet Banca.
