

The Goring to Mark Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee with a Series of Celebrations

The Goring, the only hotel to have been granted a Royal Warrant for hospitality services by Her Majesty
The Queen will host an impeccable sequence of celebrations for Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee, marking 70
years of service to the United Kingdom, the Realms and the Commonwealth

LONDON, UK – (February 2022) – The closest hotel to Buckingham Palace, The Goring has been a firm royal favourite since it opened its doors in 1910. Crafting the highest standards of hospitality for over a century by one family, in 1990 the late George Goring accepted an O.B.E. from Her Majesty The Queen at Buckingham Palace for 'services to the hotel industry'. This was followed by the granting of a Royal Warrant to The Goring in 2013 - the only hotel to have been granted a Royal Warrant for hospitality services by The Queen. This anniversary year, The Goring will commemorate Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee with a sequence of celebrations including a glorious afternoon tea, resplendent cocktails, Coronation-inspired dishes, a stay encapsulating all the Jubilee excitement and more.

Historic Coronation Dishes will be reintroduced to the Linley-designed Dining Room for another generation to enjoy, following the discovery of the very menu that The Goring created for guests in residence for Her Majesty The Queen's Coronation in 1953. The à la carte menu makes fabulous use of high-quality British ingredients, such as the revered Clarence Court hens' eggs - essential for the soon to launch St Enodoc asparagus with mimosa crusted goats cheese and confit egg yolk.

The Jubilee Afternoon Tea is an exquisite menu of fabulous cakes and sandwiches inspired by British favourites and royal milestones, topped off with a glass of Champagne. It will be served in The Veranda's beautiful pavilion overlooking the tranquil garden - a fabulous urban oasis in the heart of the city – with each bite worthy of such a monumental Jubilee milestone, from the delicate Coronation Cotswold chicken finger sandwiches to handmade pork sausage rolls.

The Jubilee Fizz and Coronation Cup Cocktails are quite simply befitting of a toast to 70 years of service. Served in the beautiful surroundings of The Goring Cocktail Bar, the Jubilee Fizz is a Champagne cocktail of Beirao, peach liqueurs and Ysabel Regina infused with banana, topped with Bollinger Champagne and a regal flourish of gold leaf. Look back to 1953 to discover the Coronation Cup, the pièce de résistance of this fine cocktail is Dubonnet - a favourite aperitif of both Her Majesty The Queen and the late Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother.

The Goring Jubilee Stay promises an exquisite two-night escape encapsulating all the Platinum Jubilee excitement: The Jubilee Tea, Jubilee Fizz cocktail with regal canapés, three-course Coronation-inspired dinner in the Michelin-starred Dining Room with Champagne to toast, and full English breakfast. A fitting room for the stay is the much sought-after Royal Suite, with its own unique collection of royal artefacts from handwritten letters and stationery to military regalia, and a guest cloakroom with walls lined with the same beautiful silk that graces The Throne Room in Buckingham Palace. Younger guests will be happy to discover the newly updated dressing up box, with outfits from Kings and Queens to Beefeaters and Guardsmen.

To honour the winner of **Fortnum & Mason's Jubilee Platinum Pudding Competition**, The Goring will introduce the triumphant pudding to The Dining Room à la carte menu.
