The Goring was opened in 1910 by Otto Goring and is now the only five-star luxury hotel in London that is owned and run by the family that built it. Deep in the heart of Belgravia, close to Buckingham Palace, The Goring is within strolling distance of the Royal Parks and some of the city's finest shops, theatres and galleries. In January 2013, The Goring was granted a Royal Warrant of appointment to HM The Queen for Hospitality Services and in 2016 The Dining Room was awarded its first Michelin star. About Villa La Massa

Villa La Massa is part of Villa d'Este Hotels group, which also includes Villa d'Este, the iconic five-star luxury hotel located in Cernobbio, on Lake Como, and the two four-star Palace Hotel and Hotel Barchetta Excelsior, in the centre of Como and overlooking the lake. The property, dating from the 13th century, is surrounded by 10 hectares of park and is located on the banks of the Arno, only 15 minutes from Florence.

It offers 54 rooms and suites divided between six villas. The hotel has two restaurants, Il Verrocchio, an Italian cuisine classic-contemporary with a focus on local products, and L'Oliveto Bistrot with Tuscan and international classic dishes. Meanwhile, the Mediceo Bar is the ideal place to sip an aperitif or one of the signature cocktails created in honour of the history of Villa La Massa. The hotel also includes a beautiful outdoor heated pool, immersed in the beautiful panorama of Chianti, and the Arno SPA, built in the ancient cellars of the hotel, with a relaxation area, sauna, Turkish bath, emotional showers, Roman whirlpool bath, gym and treatment cabins.
